The Condensery – Somerset Regional Art Gallery opened as a contemporary regional art gallery in 2015.

The gallery is located within a disused condensed milk factory. The factory was Australia's first condensed milk factory and opened in 1898. Council is seeking to further develop the cultural hub to:

- expand what is offered to the community of South East Queensland,
- provide an art workshop space,
- provide an improved entrance and shop, and
- provide a café facility with event space.

BENEFITS TO THE REGION

- A 30-year analysis of the Net Present Value (NPV) of economic benefit delivered by the gallery expansion is estimated to be \$11.8 million (at a discount rate of 7 per cent).
- The project has a cost benefit ratio of 1.93, meaning the project will return \$1.93 for every \$1 of cost.
- The project provides a strong NPV. There is a 90% probability the project will provide NPV between \$7.7 million and \$16 million for the Somerset LGA.
