

# Fernvale Sports Park

## PROONENT

SOMERSET REGIONAL COUNCIL

The Fernvale Sports Park is a 22-hectare site, with approximately 5 hectares of constructed facilities and 17 hectares of unconstructed facilities.

The facilities on site were constructed by Somerset Regional Council in 2016. The initial development of the Park included the construction of four netball courts, an Australian rules football and cricket oval, rugby and soccer field, an amenities building and a three bay storage shed. There are three permanent stakeholders that operate out of the Park; the Somerset Storm Netball Club, the Brisbane Valley Rattlers Australian Football Club and the Marburg Mount Crosby Thunder Cricket Club. The stakeholders have grown steadily in numbers since their inception or transfer to the facility. Additionally, the Fernvale State School is a recognised stakeholder of the facility. The Brisbane Valley Rail Trail is located along the southern boundary of the Park.
